In October 2022 we celebrated our 20th birthday of the Community Foundation for Cloud County (CFCC). Bob Steimel, with the help of a number of like-minded individuals, created the Foundation in October of 2002, and the assets have grown steadily every year since. Thank you to all of you who have made this growth possible by continuing to support our mission of connecting your gifts to our community needs.

As part of our continued steady growth, we are pleased to recognize the establishment of three new funds in the Foundation this year. These include two donor advised funds, USD 333 Concordia Fund, and SMC Blessings Unlimited Fund; and one field of interest fund, the Leonard and Dorothy Swenson Fund.

2022 was a year of change!

As we reviewed the 2022 yearly CFCC activities, it was difficult to find many activities that did not involve change. Arguably the most notable change was the hiring of a new executive director necessitated by the unfortunate passing of our beloved, generous, and proud founder, Bob Steimel.

After months of doing an amazing job of managing the needs of the Foundation without a director, the Board conducted a search and ultimately hired me, Brenda Gilliland, as the new executive director. This new change for me began on January 18, 2022, after working nearly thirty years as an educator. I changed from helping students to helping Cloud County citizens and you, the generous donors, fundholders, and grant applicants.

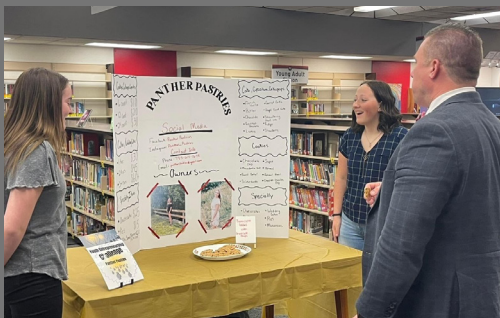

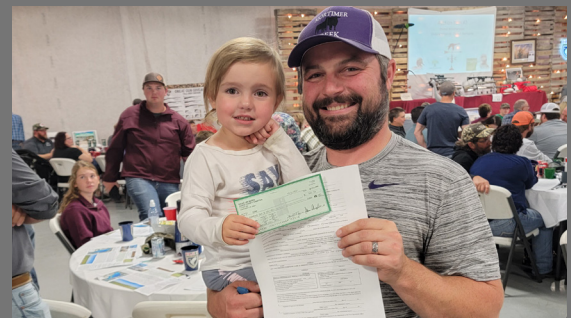

Grants

Cloud County Community College Foundation - Children's Center Expansion Project

Impact Fund for Cloud County: \$15,948.67
Dane G. Hansen Community Grant Fund (Cloud): \$4,051.36
Total: \$20,000

In the Fall of 2021, Cloud County Community College started conversations about the impact that expanding the Children's Center would have on the community. Daycares were opening around town, but the realization is there is an immediate need for long-term solutions for child care. The estimated cost for the inside of the facility was \$530,000. Financial support was received from additional grants through other organizations.

Grant funding helped purchase commercial appliances and playground equipment for the Cloud County Community College Children's Center. With this request, the CCCC Children's Center will be able to provide high quality, affordable service to more children in the community.



Neighborhood Initiatives, Inc. - Reading with Friends

Impact Fund for Cloud County: \$3,400

This program helps children engage in the story and interact with the reader and other children. Children who may not have siblings to socialize with benefit from this because they are able to develop social skills and imagination.



Concordia Wesleyan Church-Easter Egg Hunt

**Impact Fund for Cloud County & Youth Activity
Fund: \$1,500**

This event is great for community connection and is very well attended. Funding helped bring several activities to the event such as inflatables, a petting zoo, and snacks.

Brown Grand Opera House - Missoula Children's Theatre 2022

**Dane G. Hansen Community Grant
Fund: \$5,250**

Without this grant, this educational opportunity for youth wouldn't happen. The kids were able to participate at no cost to them and it introduced many kids to theatre and shared the performance with a live audience.

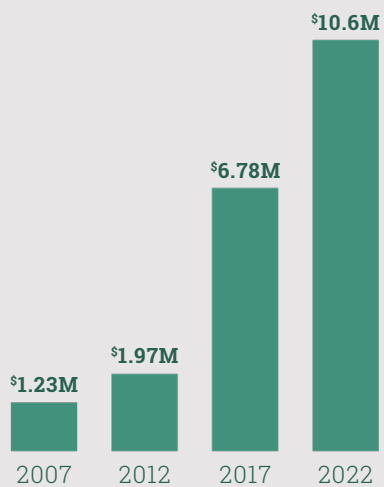

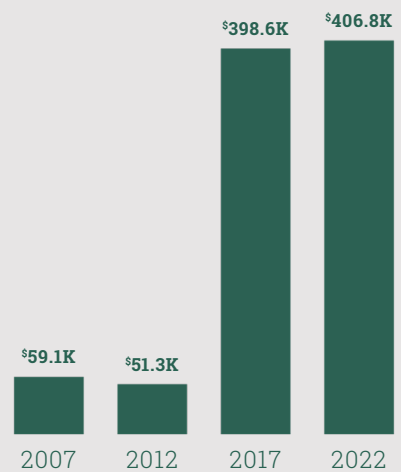

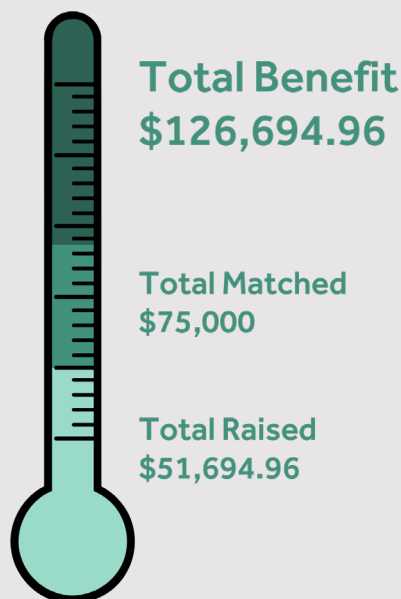

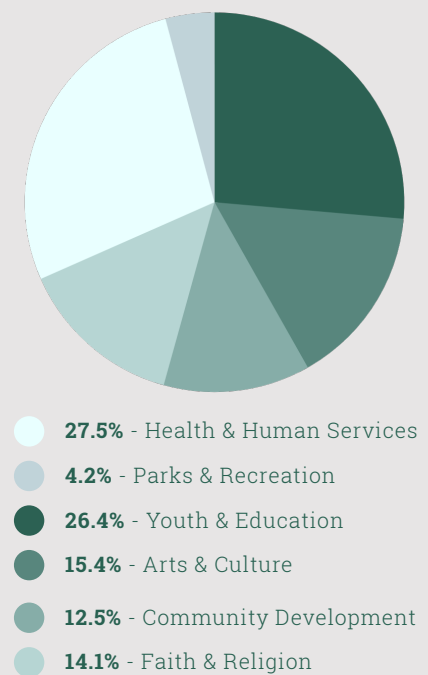
