# FROM OUR BOARD CHAIR

On April 22nd we had our quarterly board meeting led by our Executive Director Bob Steimel. The next day, Bob was gone. In just a moment, things can change.

Bob's passing has taught us to take stock of what we have, and to take time to appreciate those around us. We have taken some time to mourn our loss; now, as Bob would want us to do, we are moving forward. New funds continue to be established to support projects and organizations throughout Cloud County. Grants continue to be made, and the Community Foundation for Cloud County continues to be a "tool to be used" to empower donors to accomplish their charitable giving goals.

Bob founded, and then directed, the Community Foundation for Cloud County for 19 years. With the help of The Greater Salina Community Foundation and the Dane G. Hansen Foundation we have begun our search for our next Executive Director. The search will not be an easy one. A new Director will have giant shoes to fill. They will have different gifts and will lead us differently than Bob, but Bob established a strong foundation to build upon. We have added several new board members, and extended the expired terms of several board members by a year to further allow for the retention of their institutional knowledge.

In November of 2021, we once again participated in the Hansen match initiative. This program matches every dollar contributed to the Impact Fund for Cloud County, our unrestricted grant fund, up to \$50,000, and matches 50% to the administrative fund that provides for our operational expenses including staffing. In Bob's honor, we decided to name this the "Bob Steimel Match Initiative".

Thanks to all of the contributors, fund holders, grant applicants, board members and all who support our foundation's mission to connect your gifts to our community needs.

NW Kansas Gives is an initiative through the Dane G. Hansen Foundation to capture the significant transfer of wealth in its 26-county service area. According to a study with the Keep Five in Kansas Campaign, between 2020 and 2064 it is estimated that nearly \$30 billion will transfer from one generation to the next in Northwest Kansas, with \$2.7 billion in Cloud County.

We are partnering with the Dane G. Hansen Foundation to encourage people like you to consider leaving a portion of your estate to the Community Foundation for Cloud County in a permanent fund to benefit your community forever. If just five percent of the \$2.7 billion, or \$135 million was captured in a permanent fund, it would generate nearly \$6 million in annual grants to support causes in Cloud County.

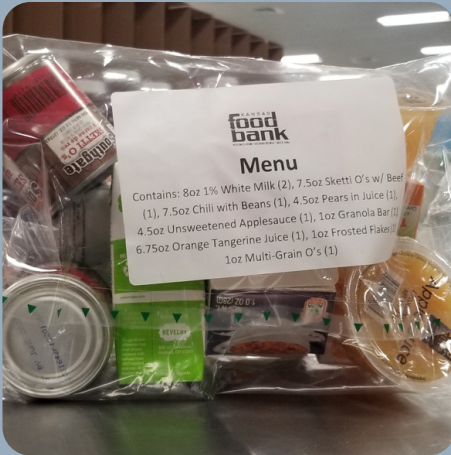

Once an outline is created, donors work with their existing attorney (or an attorney can be recommended) to complete the documents (paid for by the donor).

## FOOD 4 KIDS CLOUD COUNTY KANSAS FOOD BANK

AMOUNT: \$2,000

FUND: Dane G. Hansen Community Grant Fund

The requested funding was used to purchase weekly food packets for children who are at risk of chronic hunger. The Food 4 Kids Program was able to purchase 430 weekend packets. The program worked closely with the designated school coordinators in Concordia to make sure that any child who needed food assistance received a weekly food packet. In the 2020-21 school year, 37 children in Cloud County received weekly packets.



## PAUSE PAWS SPEAKER SERIES

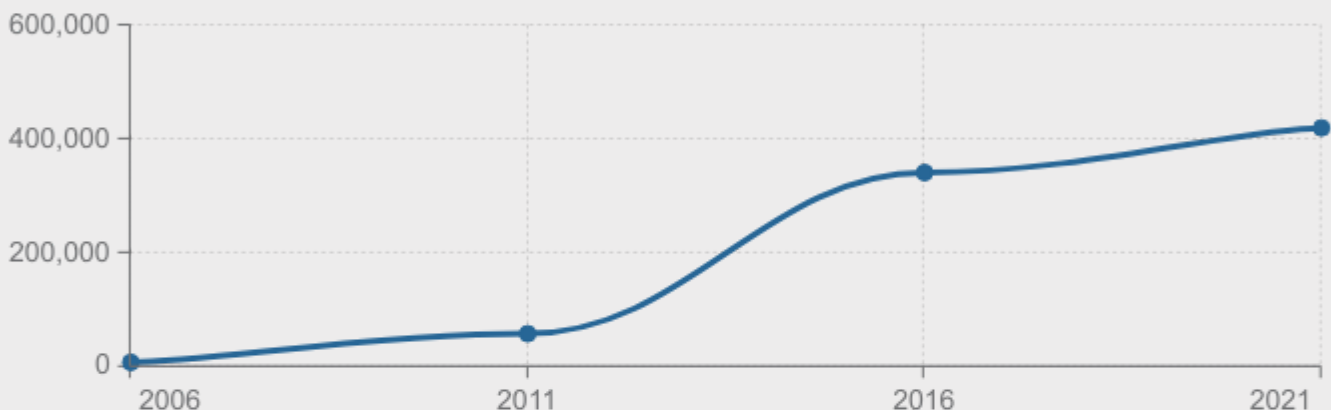

With the new speaker series at CHS, PAUSE PAWS, 16 speakers visit with around 75 students in an intimate setting similar to a "Ted Talk" platform. Speakers present for 20-25 minutes, not only about their careers, but also highlighting a value that is important beyond high school. With the grant funding received, the school was able to present each speaker with a framed honorary letter. The frame also included a plate with the presenter's name.

### Missoula Children's Theatre Summer Program

AMOUNT: \$3,800

FUND: Dane G. Hansen Community Grant Fund

Missoula Children's Theater is a summer program for students going into first grade through sixth grade to learn and to perform a play or musical to the community. It is a week-long program, and the performance was held on June 19, 2021. Many of the youth who participate do so every year they are age eligible because it is a fun and engaging activity for them to take part in. The use of this program is such a success due to Missoula Children's Theatre's staff being highly trained and experienced.

Through a generous grant from the Community Foundation for Cloud County, Missoula Children's Theatre provided the opportunity for Cloud County youth to participate in Theatre - many for the first time. Grant funds were used to pay the booking fee for the theatre, along with covering the costs of advertising, staffing, printing of materials and piano tuning.

"The Brown Grand Opera House, Inc. was thrilled to continue to offer a summer arts program for the youth in our community, especially after a year off due to COVID-19. It was a great success and exposed so many of our youth to the world of theatre," said Grantee Melissa Swenson.





## Annual Celebration of Orphan Train Riders in Concordia

AMOUNT: \$2,700

FUND: Seize the Moment Fund for Cloud County

The National Orphan Train Complex, Inc. hosted its 18th Annual Celebration of Riders this past year. The celebration focused on the New York Juvenile Asylum (NYJA), the oldest placing out organization. Our Keynote Speaker, Orphan Train Descendant Clark Kidder, presented the history & impact of the NYJA, as well as debuted his 6 volume series of books that document the history, records, and Orphan Train Riders from the NYJA.

Grant funding from the community foundation was used to secure Broadway Plaza, a tent, and Brown Grand Theatre Rental. Snacks, a horse drawn carriage, and mileage and hotel expenses for the keynote speaker was also covered.

"The continued support of CFCC allowed us to welcome attendees from 9 states, including descendants visiting the Orphan Train Town for the first time. These attendees and descendants enjoyed spending time in Concordia and are excited to return next year," said Grantee Wonda Phillips.



## COMMUNITY IMPACT BY CATEGORY

Each year the CFCC Advisory Board accepts grant applications through a competitive process and is entrusted to award grants based upon a set of criteria to meet the needs of our community. Since inception, the Board has awarded more than \$1,300,000 through its competitive grant process.

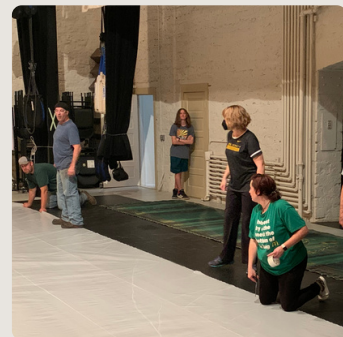

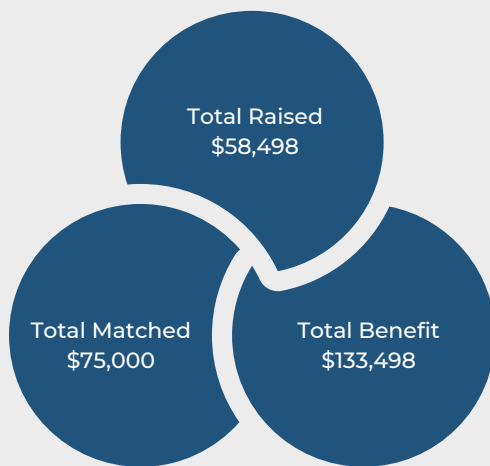

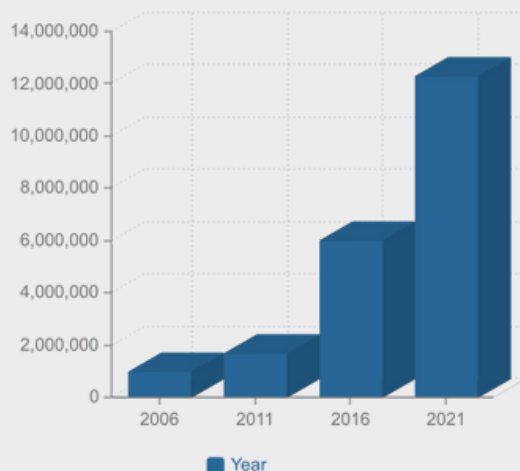


## MATCH MONTH SUCCESS
